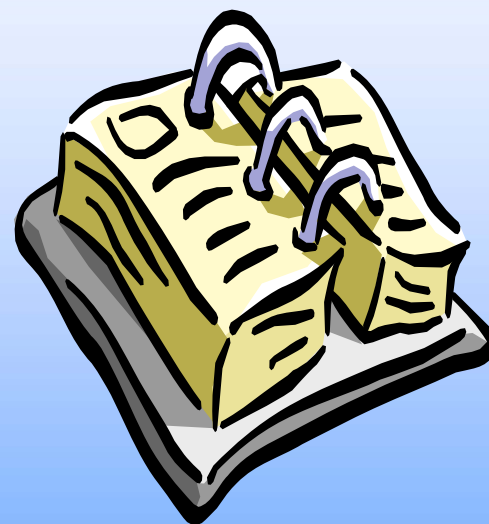
- Inventory & Forecasting Function

- Tax and Cap Policies
- Adaptation and Vulnerability

# Development of Policy Options

- Design Template:
  - Policy description
  - Policy Design
  - Potential implementation mechanisms
  - Related policies/programs in place
  - Type(s) of GHG reductions
  - Estimated GHG savings and cost per MTCO<sub>2</sub>e
  - Key uncertainties
  - Types of additional (non-GHG) benefits and or costs
  - Description of feasibility issues, if needed
  - Status of group approval
  - Level of group support
  - Barriers to consensus
