- Veva McCaig presented information to the group on the status of state efforts with respect to various elements addressed in the June 4 Initial Draft, and will provide to Stephen Saunders for inclusion in that new draft written comments on that information.
- Susan Avery will provide information to the group in advance of Meeting #3 on the new Arizona Water Institute, which may serve as a model for a new recommendation not included in the June 4 Initial Draft of Possible Recommendations.
